Kosoyu
A restoration of the old Soyu public hot spring bathhouse from over a century ago. Built in the traditional style without showers or faucets, so visitors first wash off by pouring bath water over themselves before getting in.

Closed From 6:00 to noon on the 4th Wednesday of each month (reopens at noon)

Soyu
The baths here are cleaned daily, then refilled with 100% spring water. The vaulted ceiling features large skylights for a beautiful and refreshing atmosphere, and the walls are decorated with colorful tiles hand-painted in the local Kutaniyaki style.

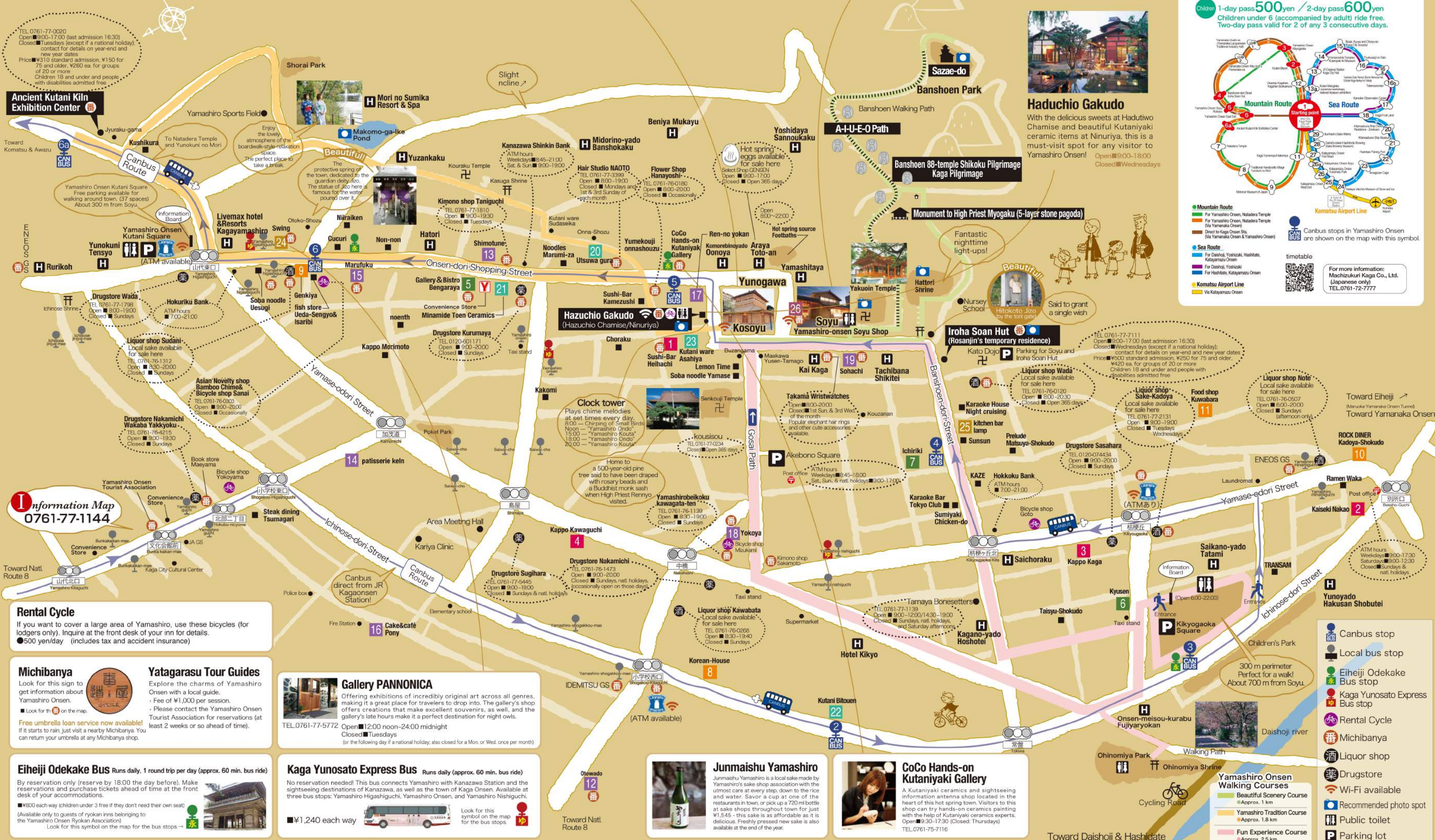
Tour Kaga on the Canbus.

With JR Kaga Onsen Station as your starting point, tour all the highlights of the Kaga district. You can get on and off the bus as you please, so you can enjoy your own special tour, hitting all the sights that you want to see.

Adults 1-day pass 1,000yen / 2-day pass 1,200yen
Children 1-day pass 500yen / 2-day pass 600yen

Eiheiji Odekake Bus Runs daily, 1 round trip per day (approx. 60 min. bus ride)

Kaga Yunosato Express Bus Runs daily (approx. 60 min. bus ride)
No reservation needed! This bus connects Yamashiro with Kanazawa Station and the sightseeing destinations of Kanazawa, as well as the town of Kaga Onsen. Available at three bus stops: Yamashiro Higashiguchi, Yamashiro Onsen, and Yamashiro Nishiguchi.

Junmaishu Yamashiro
Junmaishu Yamashiro is a local sake made by Yamashiro's sake shop association with the utmost care at every step, down to the rice and water. Savor a cup at one of the restaurants in town, or pick up a 720 ml bottle at sake shops throughout town for just ¥1,545 - this sake is as affordable as it is delicious. Freshly pressed new sake is also available at the end of the year.

CoCo Hands-on Kutaniyaki Gallery
A Kutaniyaki ceramics and sightseeing information antenna shop located in the heart of this hot spring town. Visitors to this shop can try hands-on ceramics painting with the help of Kutaniyaki ceramics experts.

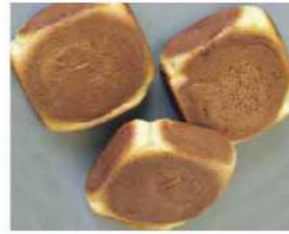
